This transition signifies a significant milestone in the progress toward a more robust and integrated service delivery model for men's programming.

## **Acknowledging Foundational Leadership**

CWEIA is acknowledged and esteemed for its pioneering leadership in founding and fostering the men's association, guiding it towards complete operational independence.

"We commend the Men of Eeyou Istchee and their ongoing commitment to healing, dignity, responsibility, and the rightful voice within the Nation," stated a representative from CWEIA. "This transition exemplifies the development and resilience of our partnership, founded on mutual respect and our shared Eeyou values."

## **Commitment to Continuity**

Effective as of November 23, 2025, MEIRA shall assume full administrative control and responsibility for the programs previously managed, including all associated assets and funding agreements.

- Seamless Service: Both organizations are committed to ensuring an uninterrupted continuation of services to all participants, with no gaps or interruptions in support for our families and communities.
- Strengthening Partnership: This transfer reinforces the vital, interdependent partnership between MEIRA and CWEIA, emphasizing collaborative, gender-inclusive approaches guided by the wisdom of our Elders and the values of respect, reciprocity, and responsibility.

Together, we are constructing a more robust and equitable future for all Eeyou/Eenou families, children, men, women, Two-Spirit individuals, and gender-diverse persons.
